In Gloucestershire:

- Crime is less than the national average
- The risk of having your home broken into is one of the lowest in the country
- On average, it takes just six weeks in the Magistrates' Court from a suspect being charged until the end of the court case
- 95% of fines imposed by the courts are successfully collected from offenders
- Offenders pay back the harm they have caused by completing 50,000 hours of unpaid work in the community each year
