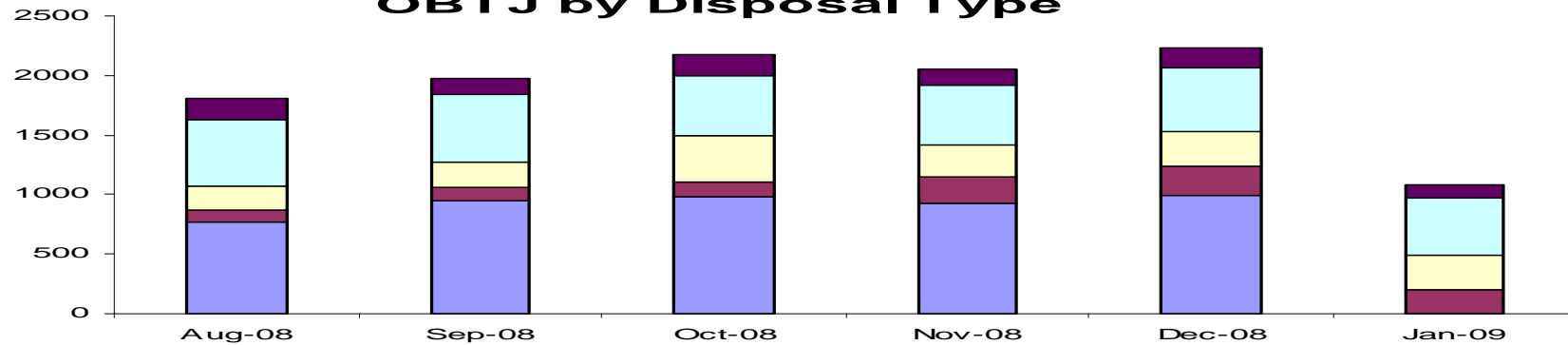

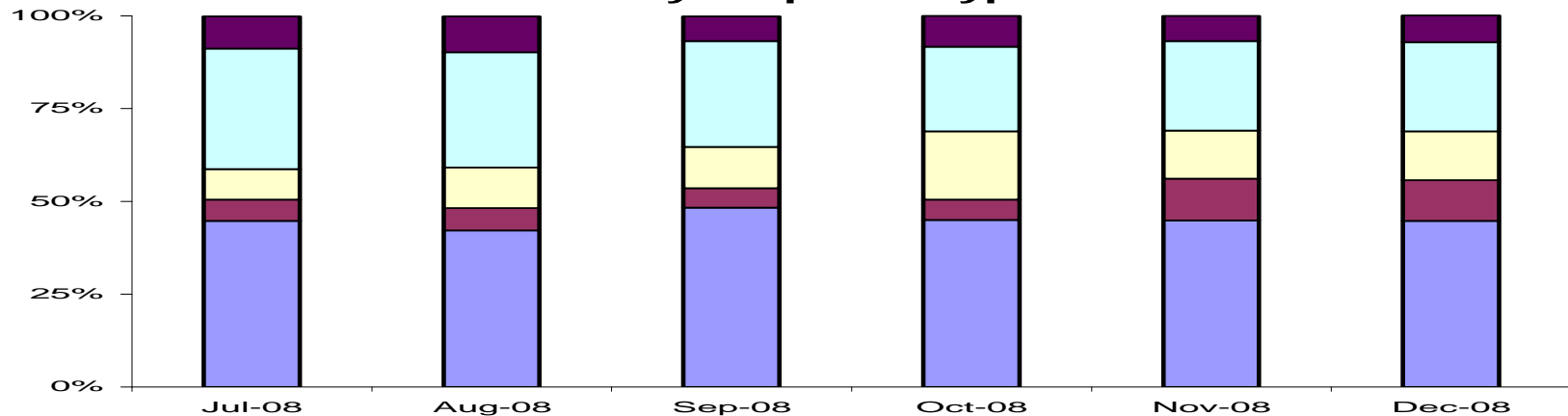

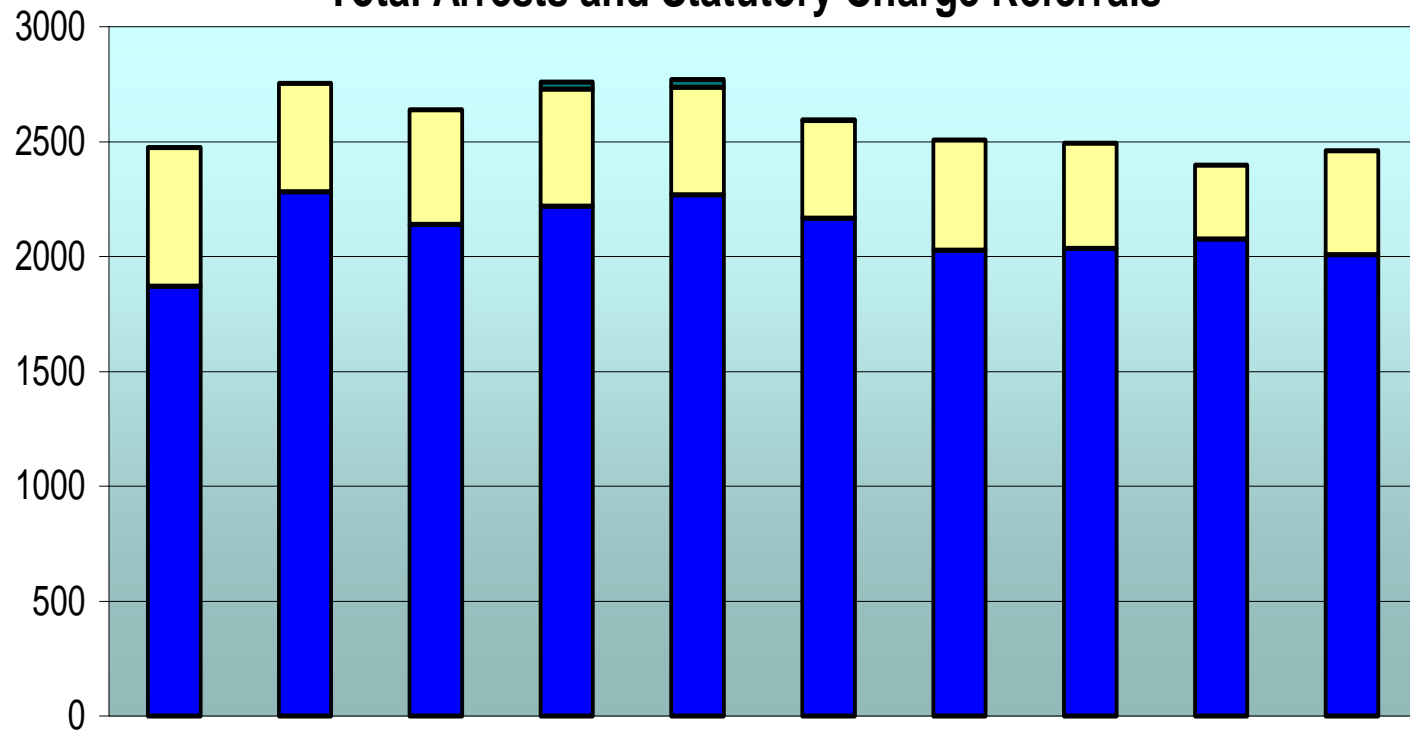


### Statutory Charge Referrals by "Last Decision Made"



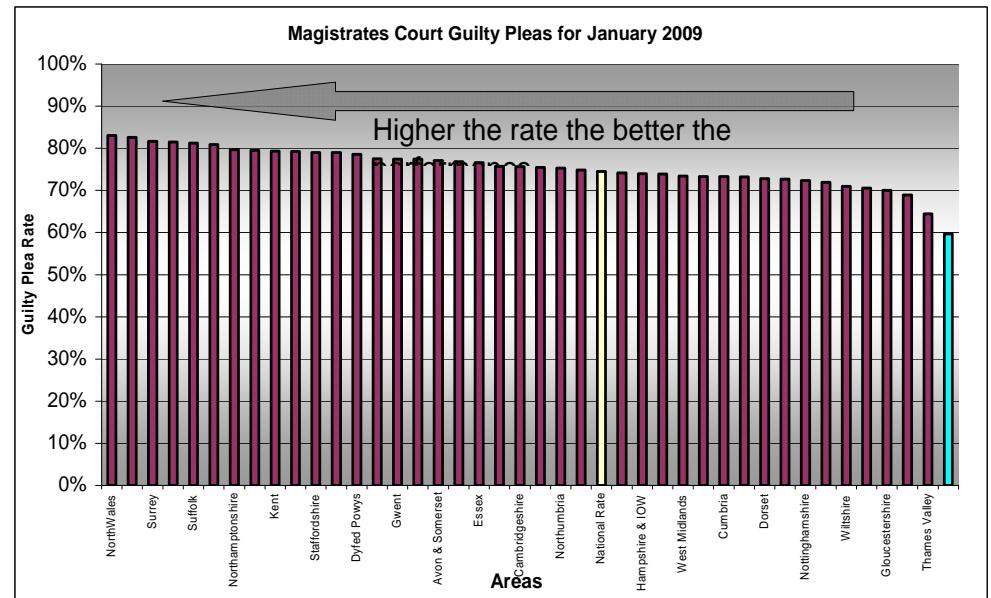
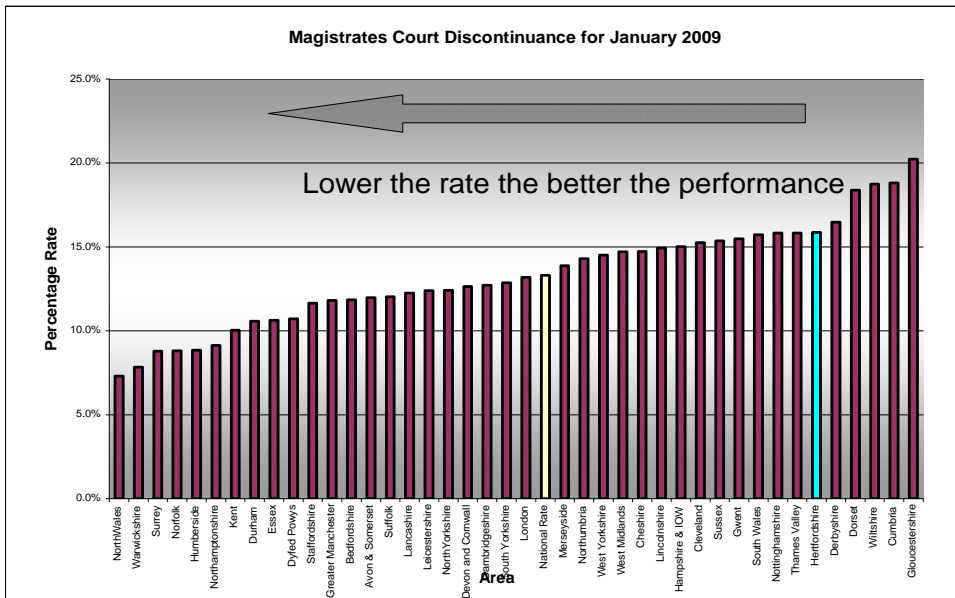
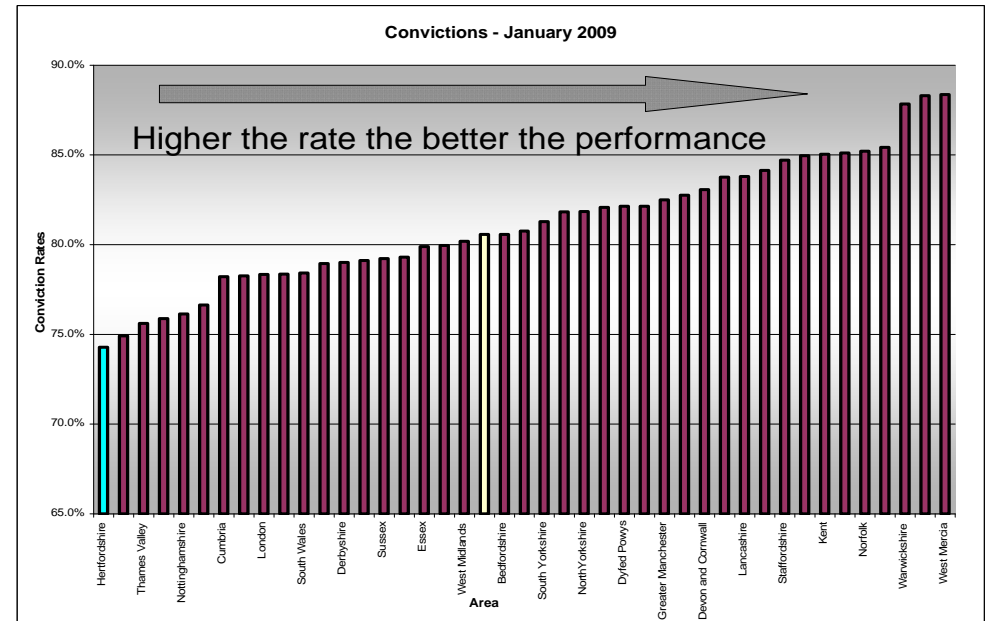
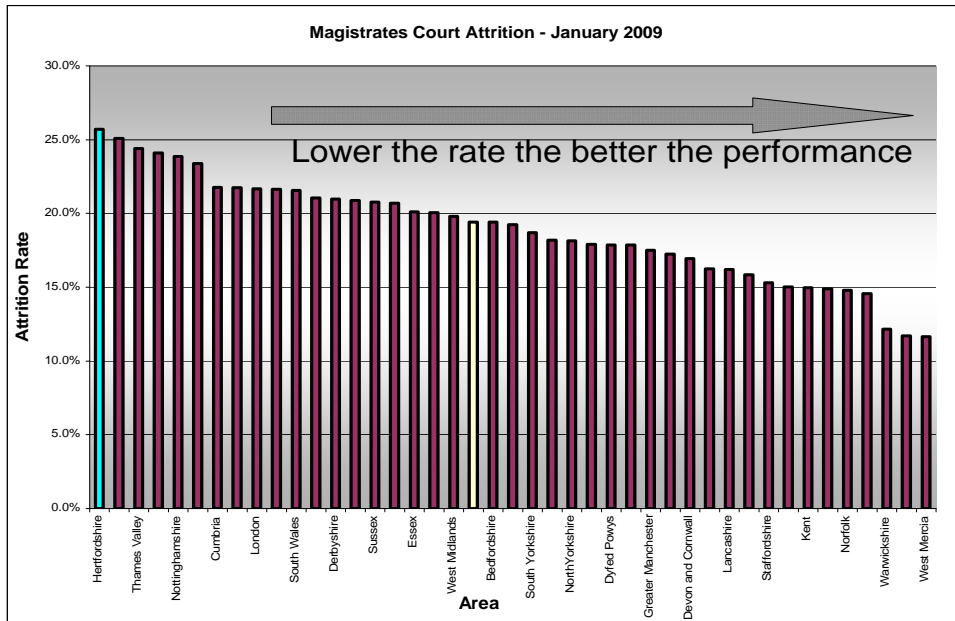

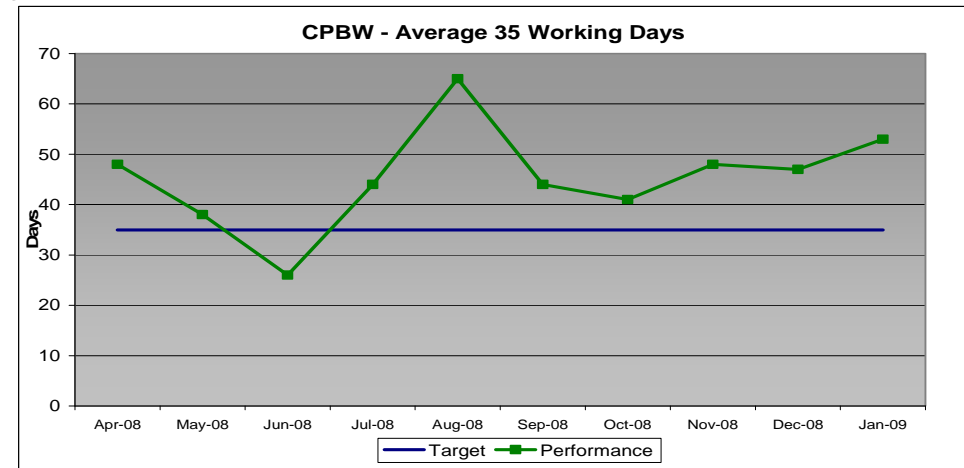

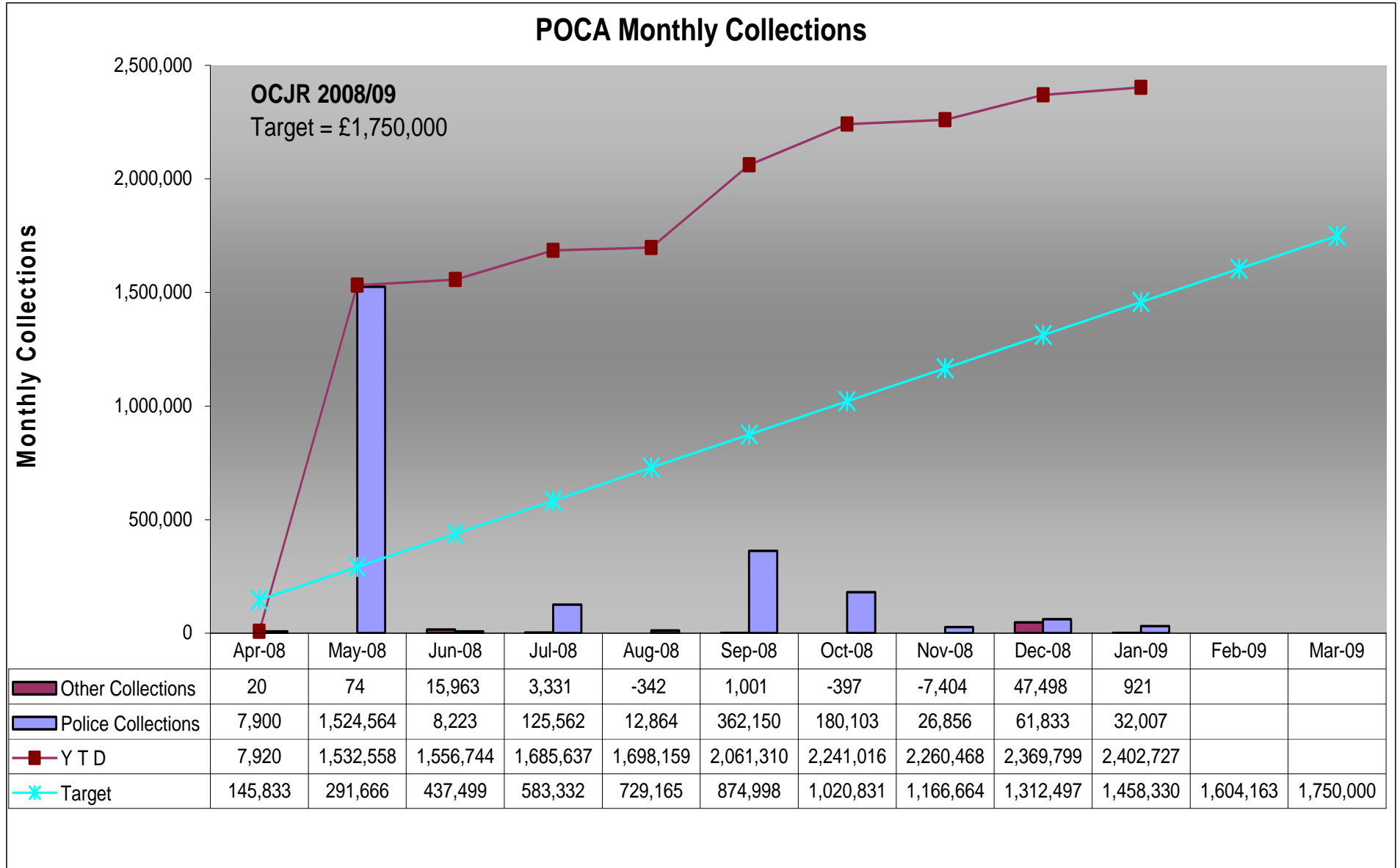

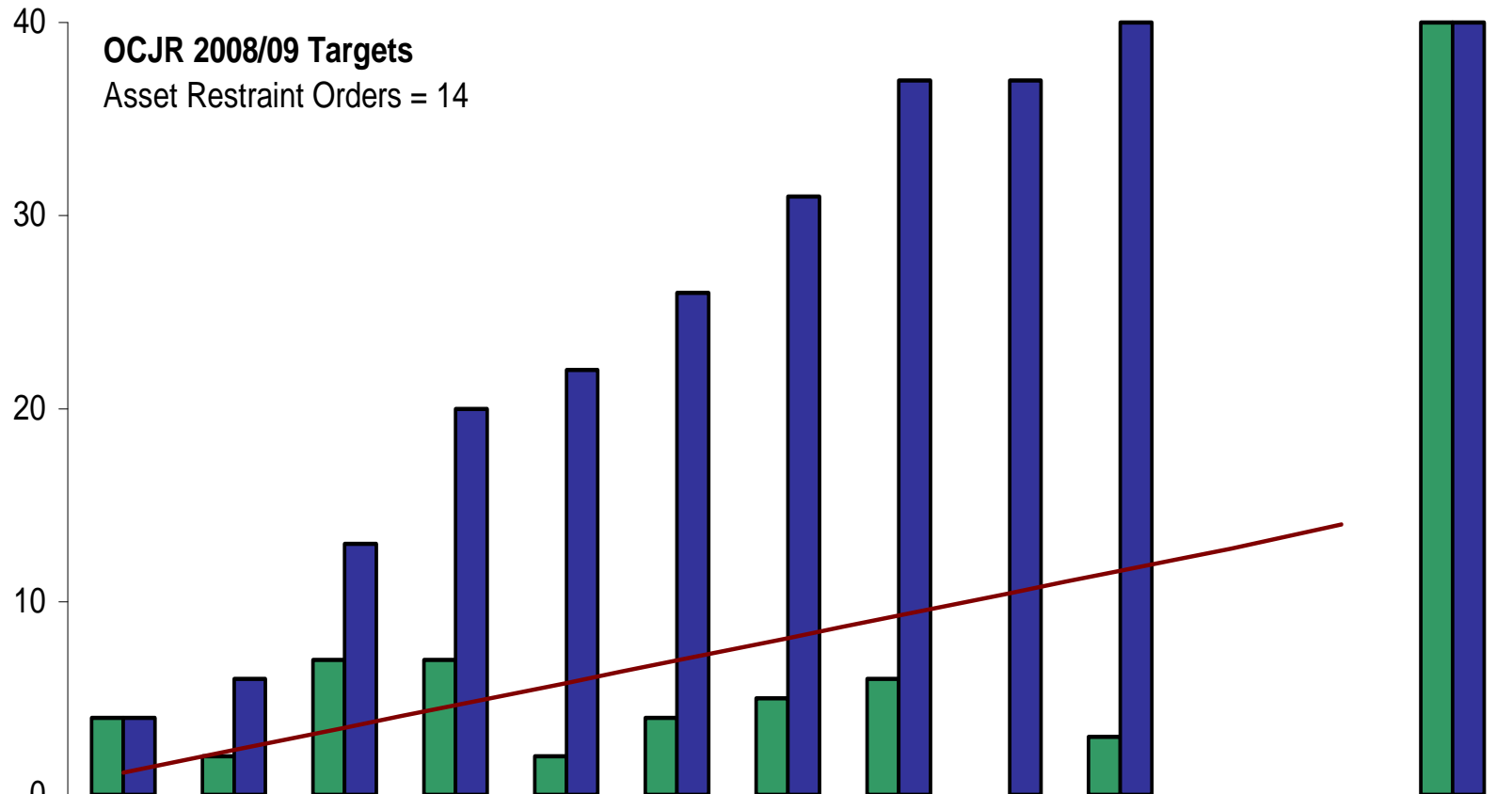

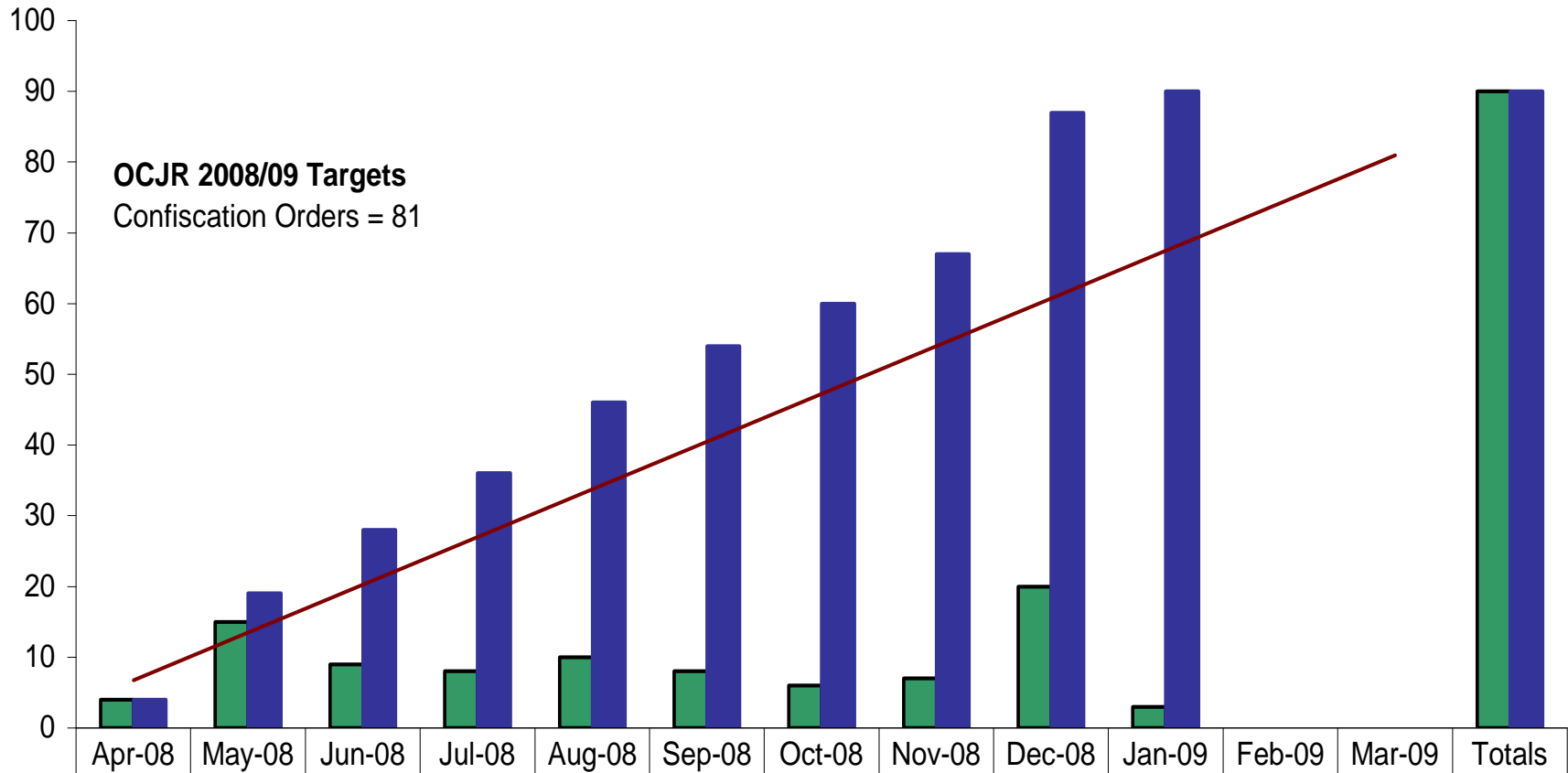

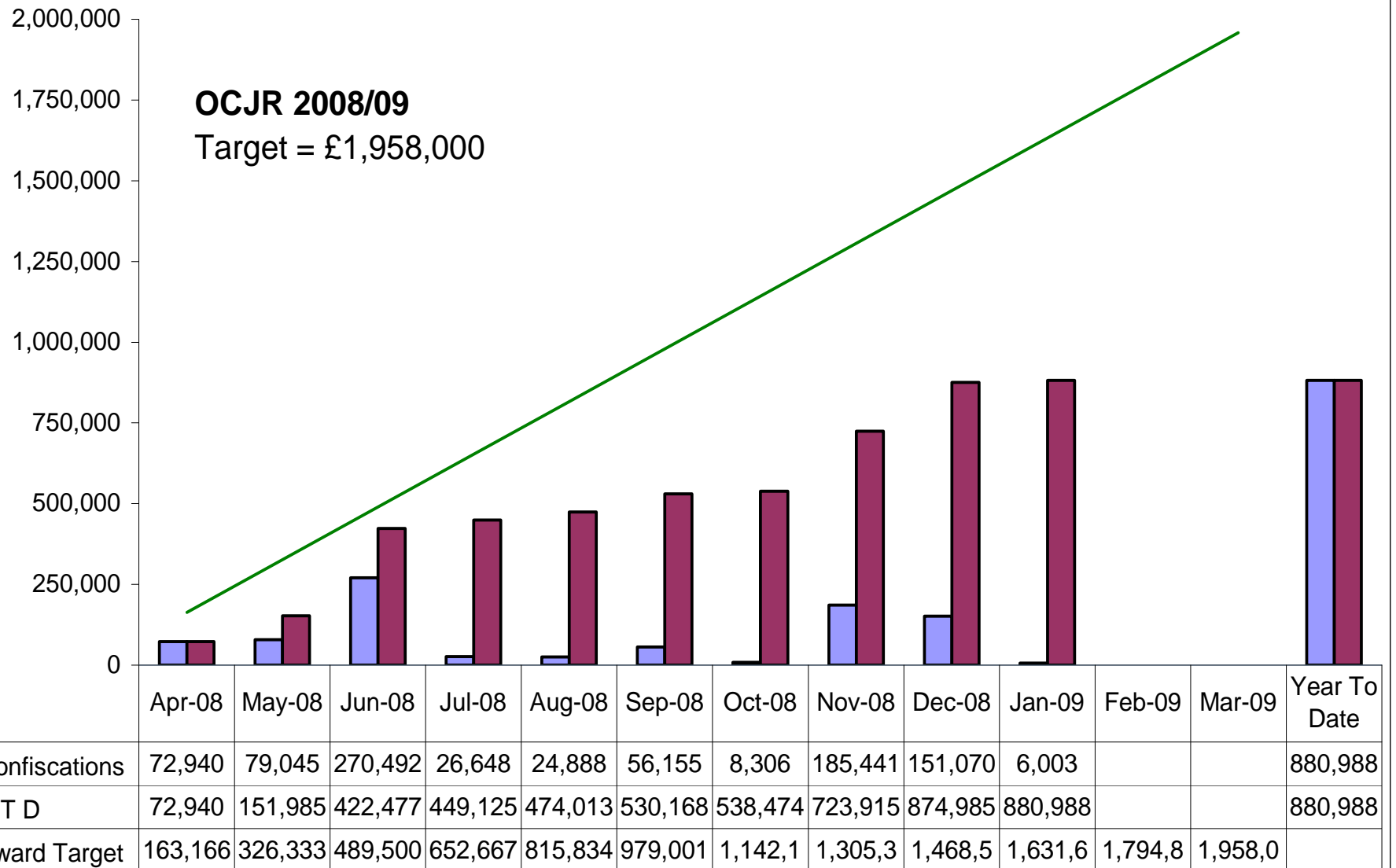

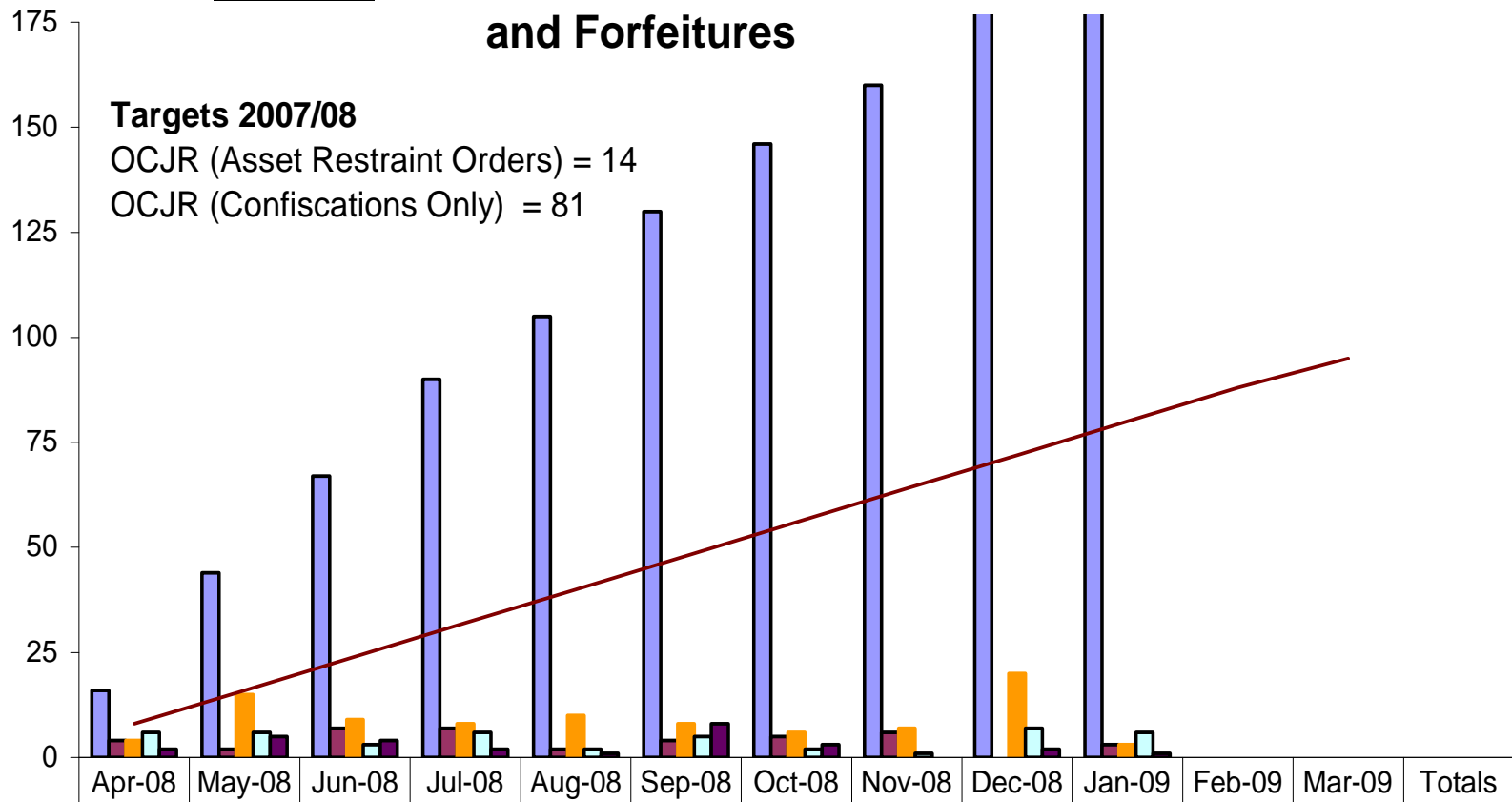

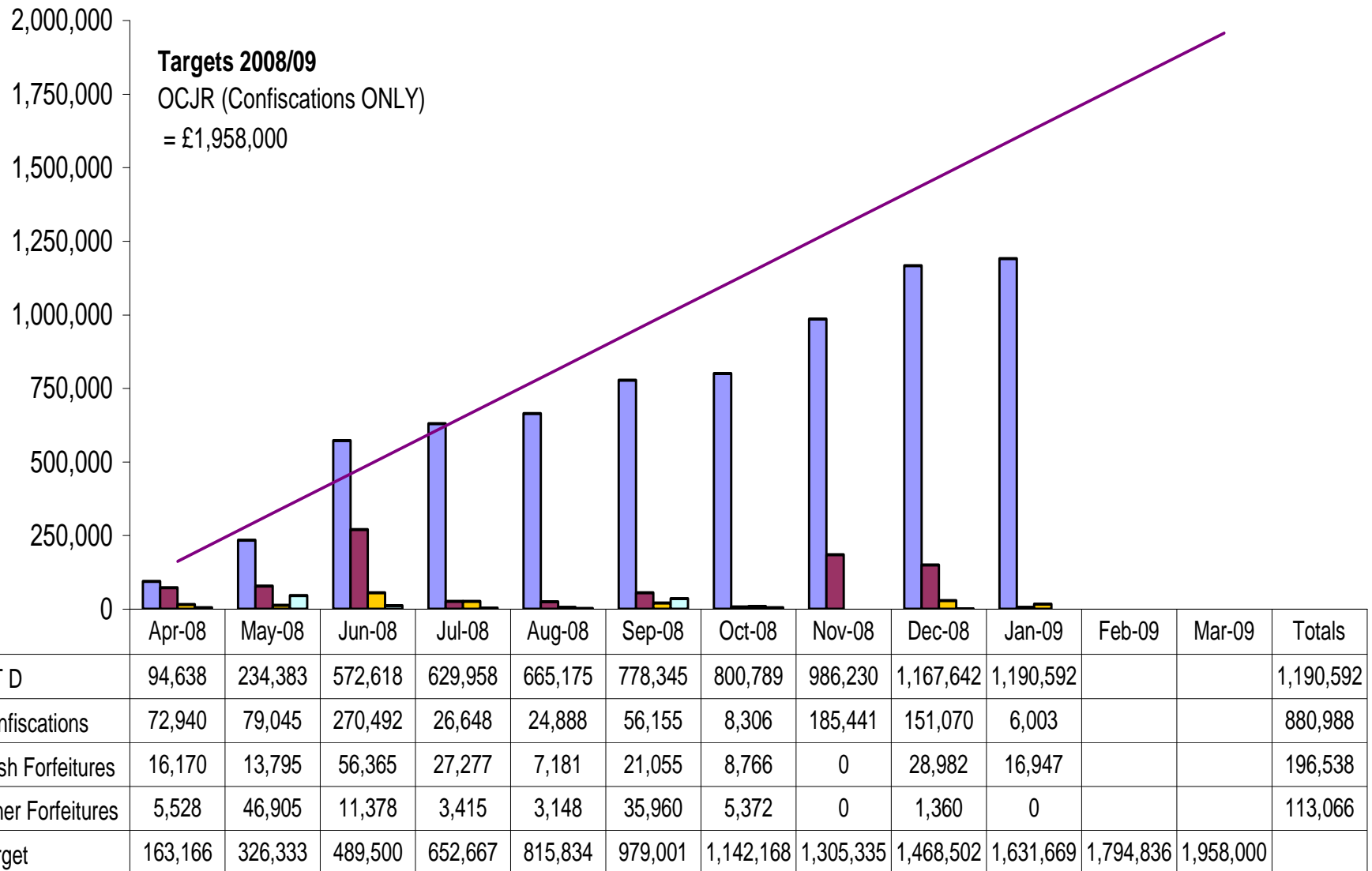
