Nomination Criteria

Nominations are welcomed from teams as well as individuals for all categories, unless otherwise stated. Teams may also nominate themselves. When nominating a team or individual, please ensure that you inform them that they are being nominated.

All nominations are to be completed on the official Dorset Justice Awards nomination form, and emailed to lcjb@dorset.pnn.police.uk by **Friday 24 July 2009**.

These awards are open to everyone who works or volunteers within Dorset's criminal justice system. Agencies that make up the criminal justice system in Dorset include:

- Dorset Police
- Crown Prosecution Service
- HM Courts Service
- Dorset Probation Area
- HM Prison Service
- Dorset Youth Offending Team
- Bournemouth and Poole Youth Offending Team

However, staff from voluntary organisations such as Victim Support and the Witness Service can also be nominated – as well as key partners who support the work done within the criminal justice system.

All nominations that are received for the Dorset Justice Awards which also fit the National Justice Awards criteria will be forwarded onto the national competition.

The Dorset Criminal Justice Board judging panel's decision is final and all nominations will be judged solely on the information submitted on the Dorset Justice Awards 2009 nomination form.

Anyone nominating or nominated for an award is deemed to have given consent for their entry to be used in any Justice Awards publicity or further promotional activities.

Award winners will be invited to receive their awards at the Dorset Justice Awards ceremony which will take place on 15 October at the Dorford Centre in Dorchester.
